What do I know about this?

Gather/organise

- ◆ What information do I have?
- ◆ How much do I understand?
- ◆ Have I met this before?
- ◆ What questions can I ask?

What is the task?

Identify

- ◆ What are my goals?
- ◆ What am I trying to do?
- ◆ What are the obstacles?
- ◆ What do I need to do this?
- ◆ Why can't I do this?
- ◆ What do I need to know?

How many ideas can I think of?

Generate

- ◆ Who can help me?
- ◆ Where can I find out more?
- ◆ What do other people think?
- ◆ How can I find this out?
- ◆ Is there another way to do this?

Which is the best idea?

Decide

- ◆ What will happen because of my decision or action?
- ◆ What are the arguments for and against?
- ◆ Which are the most important ideas?
- ◆ What is my path?

Let's do it!

Implement

- ◆ How do I check my progress?
- ◆ Am I doing this correctly?
- ◆ Is my plan working?
- ◆ What do I do next?

How well did I do?

Evaluate

- ◆ What have I done?
- ◆ Could I do it better next time?
- ◆ Did I solve the problem?
- ◆ Did I work as well as I could?
- ◆ Would I do it differently next time?
- ◆ Did I work well in my group?

Communicate

- ◆ Who can I tell?
- ◆ How can I tell and present?
- ◆ How can I explain?
- ◆ How do I interest someone else?
- ◆ Do I have the right information?

What have I learnt?

Learn from experience

- ◆ How have I changed?
- ◆ What do I think and feel now?
- ◆ How else can I use what I've learned?
- ◆ How would I do this again?
